

## Rosé of Pinot Noir 2022

## Wine:

Rosé is the fastest-growing wine category in America. We intentionally harvest Pinot Noir earlier to make our Rosé. This vintage offers hints of fresh strawberries, depicted in the charming wildflower bouquet on the label. This amazing Rosé has rich depth but also the mouth-watering crispness that we love about Pinot Noir roses.

## Winemaking:

75 % of the fruit was whole cluster pressed. The other 25% of the fruit was soaked on the skins for 12 hours before being pressed. Blended together and fermented in stainless steel. Fruit is all from Sunny Mount Vineyard Pinot Noir clones 828.

## 2022 Growing Season:

The growing season in the Willamette Valley got off to a late start with a worrisome frost. Fortunately the cold spring gave way to a longer growing season with a moderate summer and dry fall. We were rewarded with great fruit quality and higher-than expected yields at harvest time in mid-October.
